Reading: From Luther's Small Catechism

"What is Baptism? Baptism is not just water, but it is the water used according to God's command and connected with God's Word. It is not the water that forgives sins, delivers from death and the devil and gives eternal salvation to all who believe, but the Word of God which is in and with the water, and faith which trusts the Word of God in the water. For without the Word of God the water is simply water, and no baptism; but with the Word of God it is a baptism, that is a gracious water of life and a washing of regeneration in the Holy Spirit." "What is Holy Communion? Holy Communion is the real presence of our Lord Jesus Christ in and under the bread and the wine, instituted by Christ himself, for us to eat and drink. How can eating bread and drinking wine give us Christ himself you may ask? It is not the eating and drinking that does this, but the words, "Given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sins." These words, along with the eating and drinking are the main thing in the Sacrament; and whoever believes these words has exactly what they say, namely, the forgiveness of sins."
